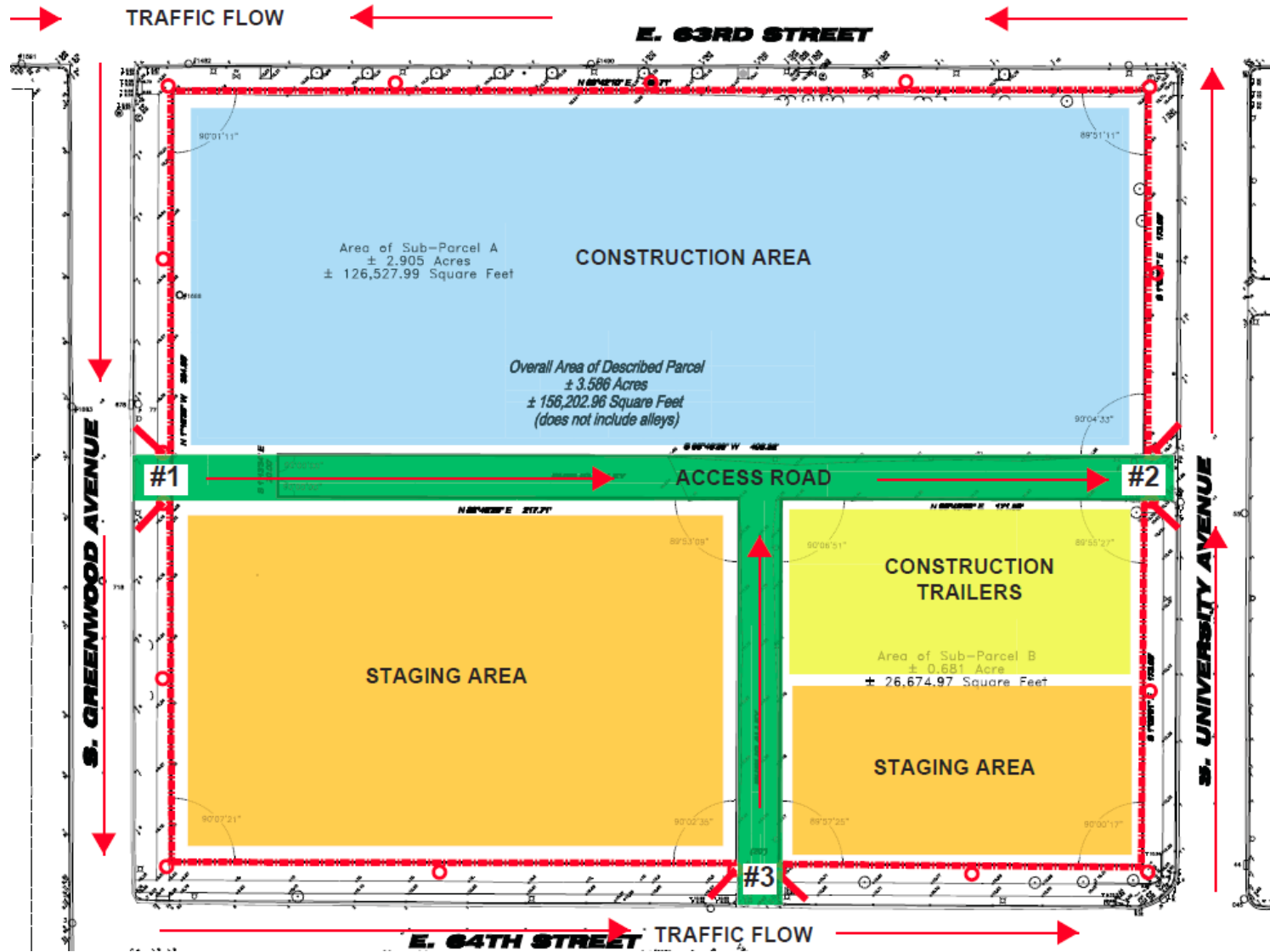

Project Timeline

- Issuance of Building Permit: **April 2016**
- Site Mobilization: **May 2016**
- Woodlawn Charter School Phase I Construction: **May 2016 – November 2017**
 - Project goals and community hiring process
 - Updates on construction activity will be communicated to neighbors
 - Construction fencing will enclose the site and trailers will be constructed for use by the building trades
 - Large pieces of construction equipment will be in use throughout the project.
 - Frequent material deliveries will be made to the site via the gates noted in the following plan
 - Sidewalks and roadways adjacent to the construction site will remain open
 - Parking along adjacent roadways will be restricted at times
 - Construction hours and activities will comply with applicable ordinances
