



The development team is proposing a two-fold approach to ensuring significant opportunities for MBE/WBE firms and the workforce in the local community:



- 1. Working with each trade subcontractor to address mentoring and local workforce opportunities.
- 2. Hosting outreach events to provide information on the potential opportunities and facilitate connections between community members, vendors, contractors, and trade unions to maximize the amount of MBE and WBE firms that work on the project.

Project Details:

- A new undergraduate residence hall with approximately 1309 beds
- A new dining hall which will be open to the public
- Ground floor university apartments along E.
 61st Street
- No PD amendment required. Site plan review and administrative relief through DPD.

Targeted Project Timeline:

City Application Submittal: January 2018
Construction Begins: Summer 2018
Building Opens: September 2020

Economic Benefit:

- Construction Jobs: 200-240 total
- Staffing Positions: approximately 15
- Meet or exceed University's economic program goal of 35% MBE/6% WBE




Elevation from 61st Street Looking North
